Lacawac Sanctuary Biological Field Station is a site for field-based ecological and environmental science research located in the Pocono region of Northeastern Pennsylvania. Habitats and resources available at Lacawac include:

- Lake Lacawac, a pristine glacial lake within a protected watershed
- Permanent and seasonal ponds, ephemeral streams, and vernal pools
- Northern boreal bog habitat
- Experimental deer exclosure areas
- Mixed hardwood and hemlock eastern temperate forests
- Long-term lake monitoring and weather station data
- Analytical laboratory
- 3-season lodging

Graduate students, post docs, and faculty conducting research incorporating Lacawac's natural resources are eligible for funding. Visit our website for more information and to apply. Applications are accepted on a rolling cycle. Review of 2023 applications will begin on May 1st, 2023.
