## ABOUT OUR FARM

Our farm is located near Gettysburg in south-central Pennsylvania. We have 360 acres which are certified organic. Our farm is a family farm and is owned and operated by us, Bill and Mary Ann Oyler. Our children Sara and Jacob work full-time on the farm as 6th generation farmers on the same land. Katrina, our youngest daughter, is a freshman in college and helps as she has time. Of the 360 acres, a little over 20 acres are planted in organic apples. In May of 2010 we purchased 23 beef cattle to utilize our 130 acres of pasture. We hope to have grass finished beef for sale by late 2012. As stewards of the land we strive for healthy soil and subsequently healthy plants. We planted 8 acres of peach and apple trees over the past few years and hope to have a few organic peaches and new apple varieties for sale this year!

## ORGANIC APPLES

The varieties of apples that are bearing and their approximate maturity dates are:

- \*Golden Supreme      \*York  
1st week of Sept.      3rd week of Oct.
- \*Golden Delicious      \*Braeburn  
3rd week of Sept.      4th week of Oct.
- \*Red Delicious      \*Fuji  
4th week of Sept.      4th week of Oct.
- \*Ida Red  
1st week of Oct.

Your share will include different varieties as they ripen. For example, you may receive all Golden Supreme apples in the beginning of September and a mix of Red Delicious and Golden Delicious at the end of September.

### ~For Your Information~

A half peck of apples includes roughly 12 apples (about 5.25 pounds), however this may vary depending on the size of the apples.
