Frantive Slave Case!—A case of this description came up last night, before Levi Davis, Esq., U. S. Commissioner for Alton. The fugitive was a young colored woman, who came to this city thirteen months ago, in care of a young white man, the son of her master, who lives in Memphis. The son brought her to Alton, and set her free. The parties who came after her proved her a slave.

The woman had been married to a young man in this town, by the name of Chaver, three weeks ago. The case was a clear one, and no doubt our citizens, will abideby the laws of the country, and see them respected. It may be well to meetion, that the young woman was not much affected, if any, at her situation, so far as a looker-on could discern. The husband also acted very prudently, as well as the crowd of colored persons, and others, whom the circumstances had drawn together. A morement was made to purchase the freedom of the girl, late last evening.
