Slave Excitement at Chicago. MILITARY CALLED OUT—THE ALLEGED SLAVES LIEERATED.

CHICAGO, Dec. 8, 1854.

Seventeen Missouri slaves have arrived here. There are men from St. Louis attempting to arrest them. The United States Marshal endeavored to summon the posse comitatus. Three military companies were called out, but only one responded to the call. Great excitement has been occasioned by the presence of the slave captors. Intimidated by the crowd of people, the Commissioner dismissed the proceedings. The excitement is now abating.
