Another Fugitive Slave Case at Chicago.

CHICAGO, Wednesday, April 3.

A colored man named HARRIS, with his wife and two children, were arrested here this morning on a warrant issued by United States Commissioner Con-NEAU and sent by special train to Springfield, where they will be examined to-morrow. The man is claimed by Mr. Patterson, of St. Louis County, Mo., and the woman and children by Mr. Vail, of the same County, from whence they escaped. As it was almost entirely unknown that warrants were issued they were executed with little difficulty, but after the affair became known the most intense excitement prevailed among the colored portion of the community, and large numbers gathered at the dépôt at the time the regular morning train left, the crowd supposing the fugitives to be aboard. One or two shots were fired at the train. Beyond this there was no disturbance.
