ORGANIZATION DESCRIPTION:

The LEAF Project is in our 10th year of cultivating youth leaders from diverse backgrounds through meaningful work in the food system. LEAF creates a rare and powerful space for youth leaders to experience their capacity and engage in building a resilient food system through year round positions of increasing responsibility. On our 4 acre home farm, LEAF runs a sustainable vegetable farm and good food ventures that feed our community through farm shares, restaurant partnerships, public health partnerships, and thoughtful donations. Through seasonal internships, LEAF youth also engage in their own leadership development, workforce readiness skills, and move on to positions of increased responsibility running LEAF ventures in our community.

POSITION SUMMARY:

At the heart of our mission at LEAF is working with young people to help uplift and cultivate diverse young leaders. The role of Crew Leader will have a direct impact on this mission. Throughout the summer, you would be serving as a mentor for a group of seven young people aged 14-18.
