It is with pleasure and at the same time regret that I take this opportunity to notify you that Stephen P. Meier, presently a Corporal in the U. S. Army Ordnance Corps assigned to the Aberdeen Bombing Mission Special Weapons Branch, Kirtland Air Force Base, New Mexico, is being released from active duty on or about 4 June 1955.

Prior to being called to active military duty Cpl Meier was employed by your Division of Radio Corporation of America.
