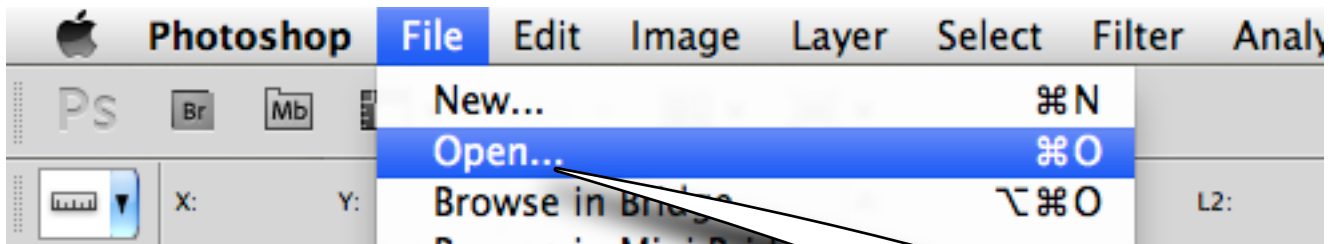
Select adobe photoshop from application folder or from the bottom of the screen



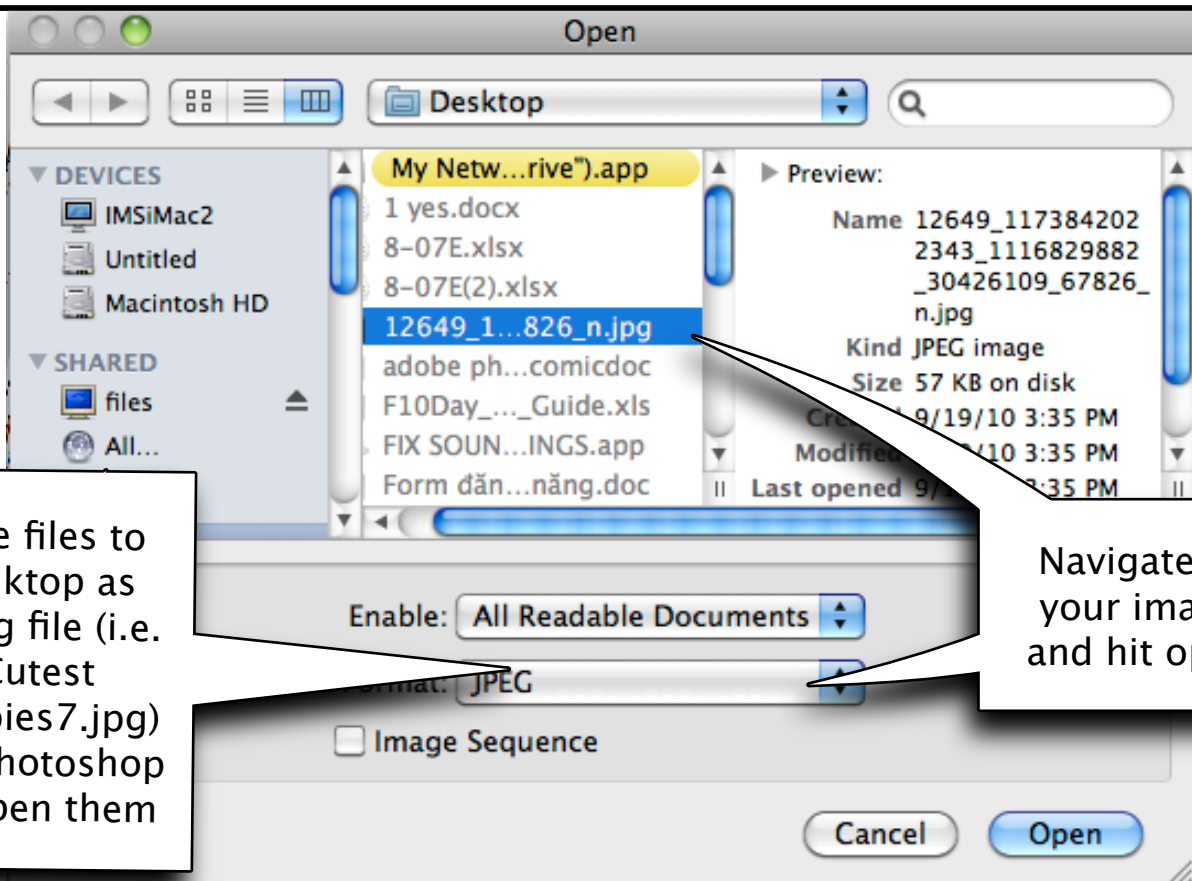
Photoshop will set up like this

OPEN AN IMAGE



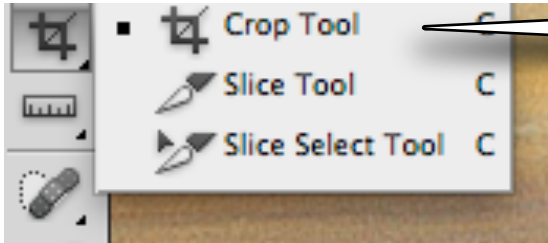
To open a new image, select file> open



Save files to desktop as a .jpg file (i.e. Cutest Puppies7.jpg) for photoshop to open them

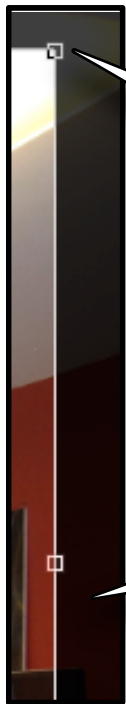
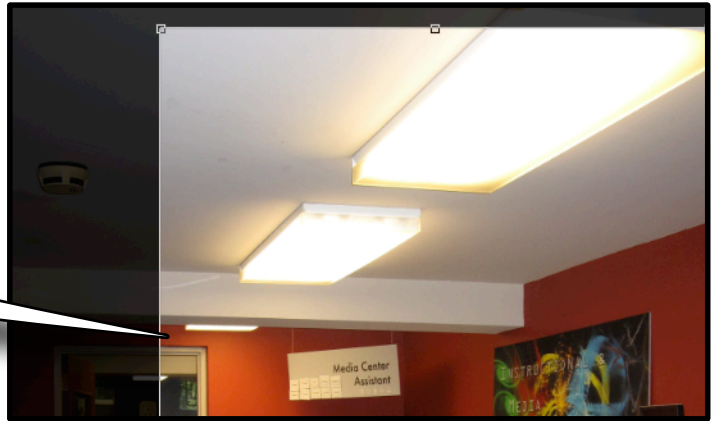
Navigate to your image and hit open

CROP image



select crop tool from the tool bar on the left

drag on the image to select the section that you wish to keep



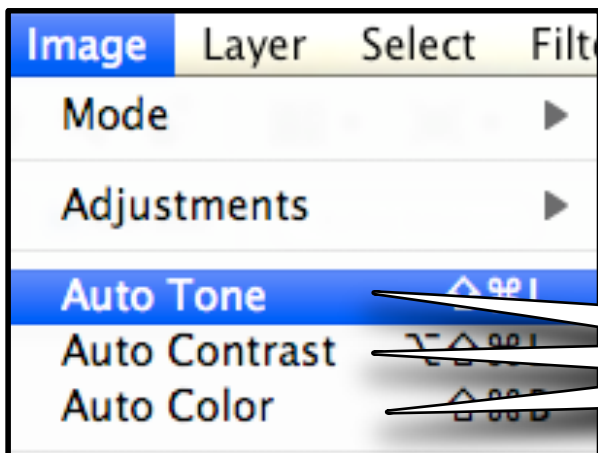
you can adjust the selection by dragging the square on the edge of your selection

Notice: you can press "command +z" at any time to undo changes or choose edit "undo" or "step backwards"



double click on the selected section to finish cropping

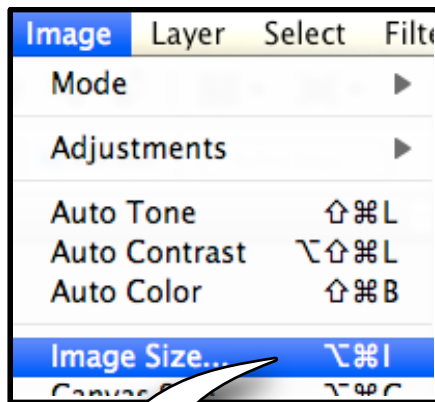
auto tone, contrast & color



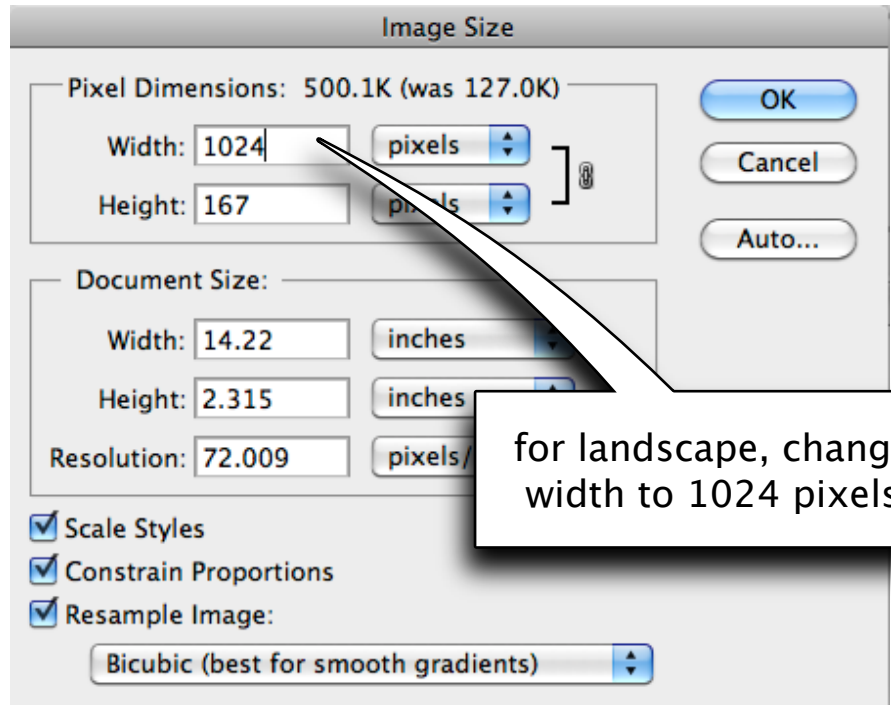
to refine your image, select image> auto tone/contrast/color

for portrait, change width to 800 pixels



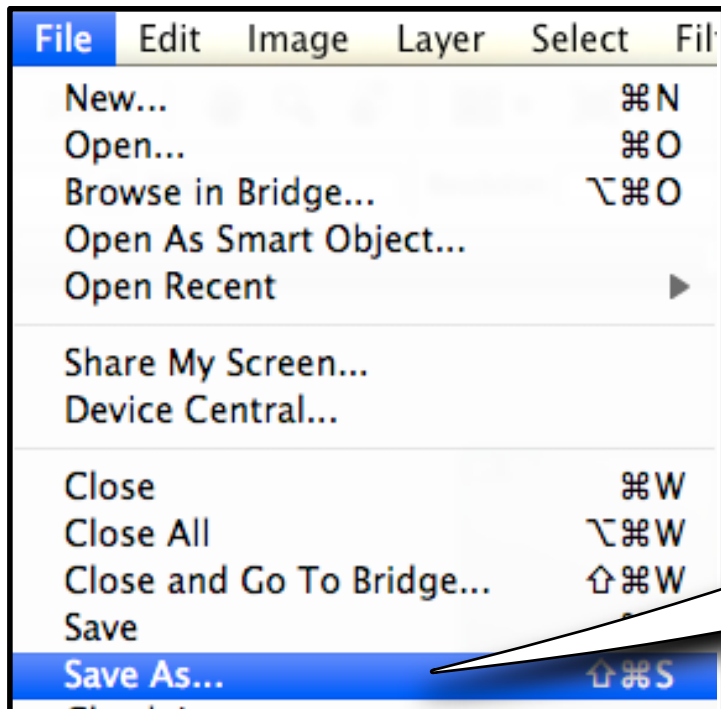
