



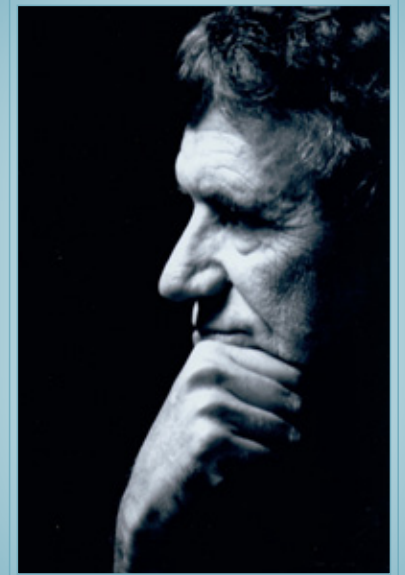
Caribbean Cinema: Issues of Representation, Historical Development and Film Practices

He is an award winning filmmaker, having made over 500 films and television programmes, mainly on Caribbean culture. His 2006 documentary, "The Mennonites of Belize," received the award as the best cultural and educational programme by the Caribbean Broadcasting Union in 2007.
