Why are you thinking about going to graduate school?



## PHD OR MS?

If you want to pursue an MS in the US, you might want to apply for a PhD program with the (secret) intention of mastering out.

#### PhD (or equivalent doctorate degree)

- **⇒**Longer duration\*
  - ◆ 5-7 years (US) no MS required
  - ≈ 3 years (elsewhere) MS required
- Research-focused
- ◆Paid for research (STEM) and teaching
- Tuition paid by program

#### MS (or equivalent master's degree)

- Shorter duration\*
  - **1-2** years (US)
  - 2-3 years (elsewhere)
- Coursework-focused
- Less likely to be paid for research and teaching
- Tuition paid by student

<sup>\*</sup> Duration depends on program, institution, full-time versus part-time, and personal factors

## CV/RÉSUMÉ (US)

#### Résumé

- ◆1-2 pages
- Skills for specific role
- Usually for industry

#### CV (curriculum vitae)

- No limit for length
- Record of everything
- Usually for academia

### LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

#### Pick letter writers who

- Know you well and have worked with you
- Can comment on your research skills (e.g., from lab coursework)
- Can comment on your growth
- Can address skills/experiences other writers can't

#### **Tips**

- Give at least one month notice (but ask ASAP)
- Send list of ideas for letter content

## LIST

### GENERAL TIPS

- Start your applications early!
- Get feedback from friends (and the Writing Center!).
- Ask for fee waivers.
- Start with higher priority applications first in case you get tired.
- Demonstrate growth and an eagerness to learn.
- ◆Tailor each personal statement to the application.
